As indicated on our Web site, there are two stations in Orleans: "Orléans Les Aubrais" (Named sometime "Les Aubrais" on Internet) and "Orléans Centre". Except the TER trains to avoid since too many stops, the «Orléans Les Aubrais» station is the first stop from Paris. Trains shown in the first table stop first at "Orléans Les Aubrais", then go to "Orléans Centre". On the other hand, trains shown in the second table do not go to Orléans, it is therefore imperative to get off the train at the first stop (station « Orléans Les Aubrais »).

Leaving the "Orléans Les Aubrais" station, you have TRAM stop on your right. Without crossing the rails for TRAM, you are in the right direction (direction: Hôpital de La Source) to go to downtown or go directly to the Campus

You must purchase your ticket on the platform either with coins or with a credit card. The price is 1.5€. The ticket is valid only if you insert it into a small machine while entering in the TRAM. The LOC will probably provide you a weekly ticket for public transportation.

Coming from Paris, if you go directly to the campus for registration, five trains highlighted in yellow are ideal, we propose you to get off at the “Orléans Les Aubrais”, since for the arrival of these 5 trains (14h05, 16h25, 18h05, 18h25 and 18h34), there are young volunteers with "GD2014" sign at the “Orléans Les Aubrais” station for welcoming you.

If you are not familiar with the French train, here is some helpful information: you can buy your ticket at ticket windows or ATM. If your tickets like those illustrated by the figure below, to validate them, you must to punch them by using the machines illustrated below (available at the beginning of the platform).



If you get off the train in Orleans and you want to take the TRAM, the passage to the TRAM stop is located near the escalator (on the left and farthest corner of the Hall).



In case of a strike, there will be fewer trains and you can get, the day before or two days before, the train schedules which will really operate thanks to the Web site (<http://www.infolignes.com/index.php?lang=en>).

Come to Agora or GD2014 venue (Conf. Rooms) by TRAM

You get off at “Université – Pac Floral” stop, and follow the directions indicated on picture below. On Sunday, you go to Agora for registration and for reception and on Monday, you go to Conf. Rooms. From train station “Orleans Centre”, you need about one half hour; from “Orleans Les Aubrais”, you need about 40 minutes.
